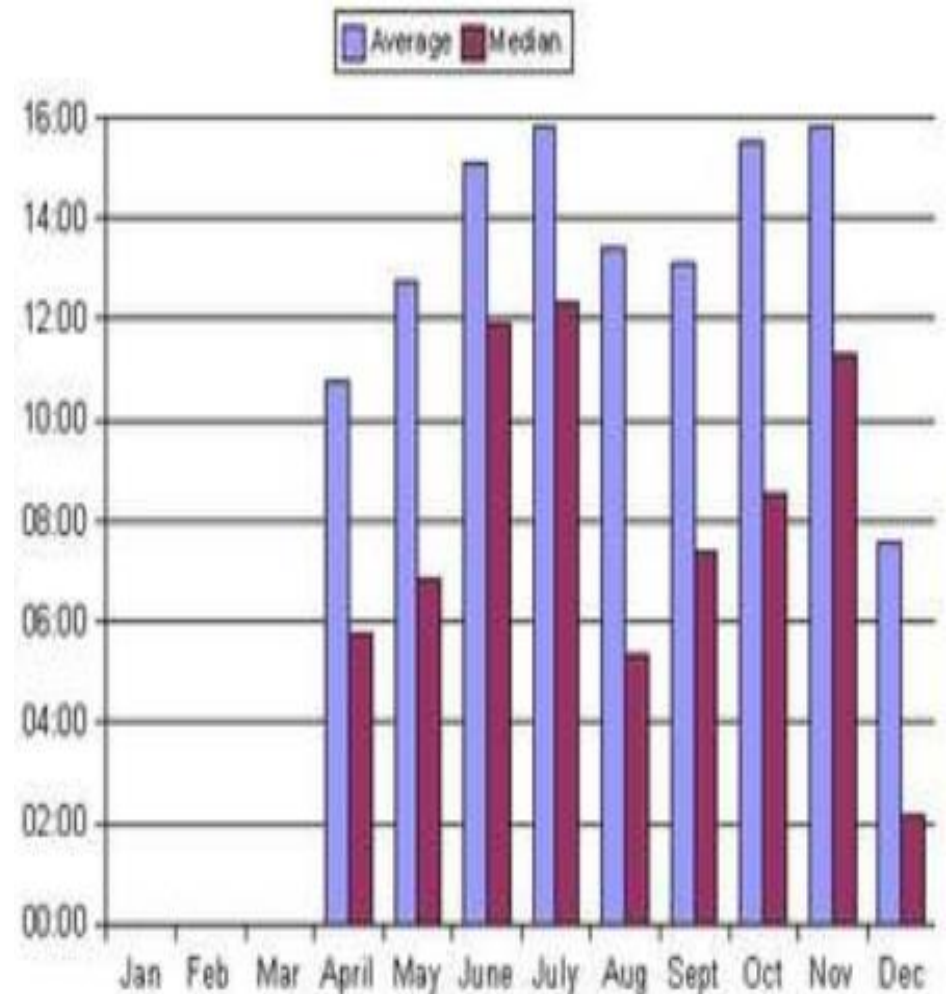

 - etc.



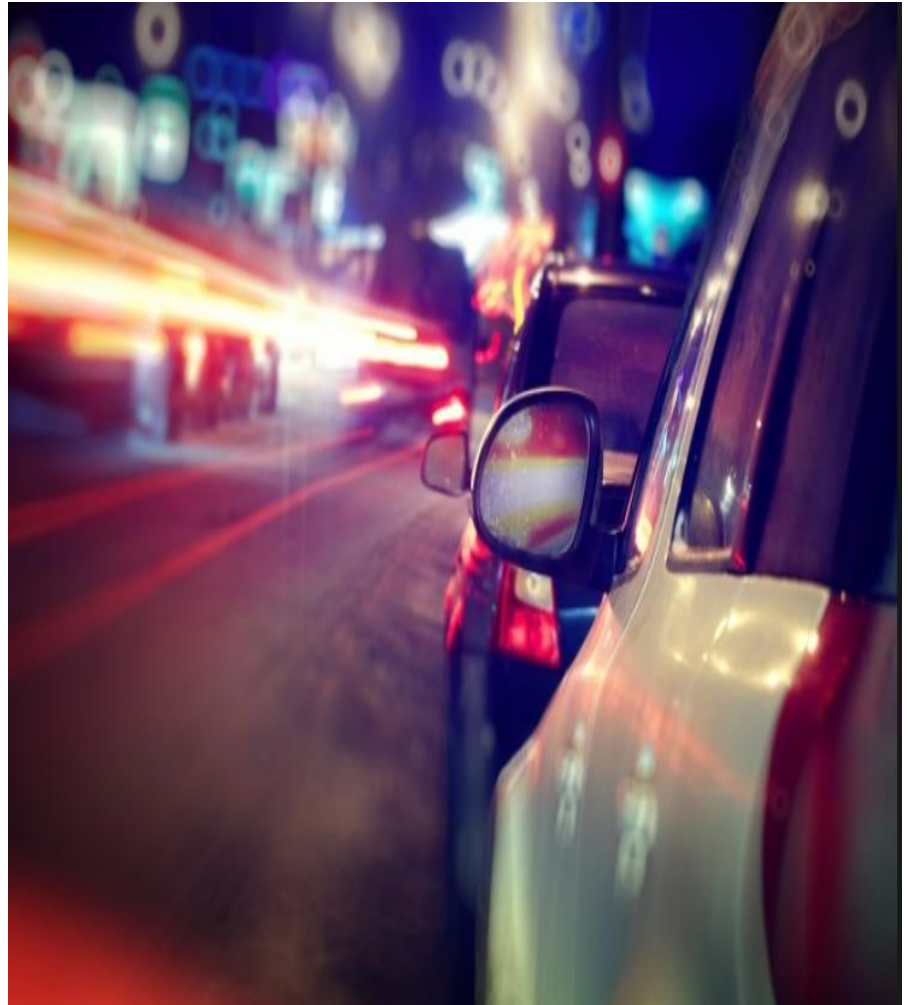
3. Road Safety Analyses in Africa

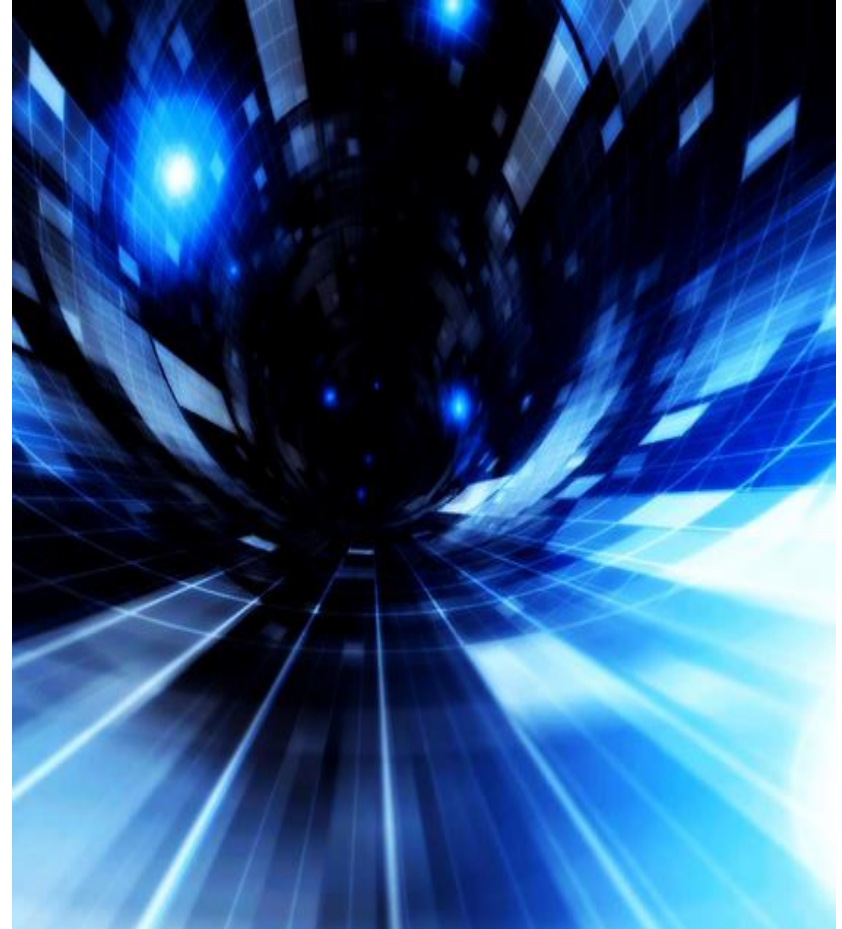
