Scope of Work



Background

- Most of the countries adopt and implement strategic plans and/or Action Plans with specific targets for more than two decades as a key success tool to continuously improve safety.
- Reducing road fatalities and serious injuries by 50% by 2030 is the target adopted in most National Road Safety Strategic Plans.
- Safe System Approach and Vision Zero are being adopted in the vast majority of the Strategic Plans.





Scope of Work

➤The objective of this IRTAD Sub-Group is to propose a systematic monitoring of the implementation of national strategies and related programmes, actions and measures/interventions.

➢On that purpose, a framework of quantitative and qualitative indicators of road safety measures implementation should be attempted in order to support National Authorities.



Monitoring Approach Key Elements

Road Safety Performance Monitoring

- final road safety results (road crashes and casualties)
- interim results KPIs (road users' behaviour, road infrastructure safety, vehicle safety, emergency response time)

Monitoring Actions' Implementation

- systematic collection of information
- measures progress reports
- use of monitoring indicators

Evaluation of Actions' Effectiveness

- collection of necessary data
- appropriate methods and evaluation indicators
- reliable implementation of the evaluation methods
- publication of evaluation results






Open Issues



- 4. Pilot test the framework in view of the mid-decade strategies review



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
