

Attitudes towards (un)safe traffic behaviour, in Europe



85% recognises the increasing risk of accident

compared to 82% for talking on a hand-held phone

Only about 60%

of the Europeans reported (almost) always

securing children

travelling with them correctly while being aware of the risks of making children travelling without appropriate restraints (87% agreement)

Women and elderly

generally have more negative attitudes towards unsafe traffic behaviours

- DUI fatigue & distraction seat belt speed (1) % of agreement: scores 4 and 5 on a 5-point scale from 1 'disagree' to 5 'agree'.
- (2) Some items were formulated positively, and others negatively which is indicated by the dotted line.
- (3) European weight B. In Slovenia, the question 'talk on a hand-held mobile phone' refers to talk on the mobile phone while driving, without limiting it to hand-held mobile phone use only.
