1. NTUA Road Safety Update

2. European Road Safety Observatory

ERSO (the European Road Safety Observatory) aims to assist policy makers, researchers and road safety advisors in all aspects of road and vehicle safety policy development at European and national levels. The ERSO has been first



developed as a pilot stage during the period 2004 - 2008 within the RTD project SafetyNet. Since then, the content of ERSO has been integrated into the "Europa" Commission Road Safety website.

3. Road Safety PIN Talk in Athens

The Road Safety PIN Talk was organized by the <u>European Transport Safety Council</u> and the <u>Road</u> <u>Safety Institute Panos Mylonas</u> in Athens on November 15th, 2006. This Road Safety PIN Talk



enters within the framework of the Road Safety Performance Index of the European Transport Safety Council, having as objective to monitor and boost progress of road safety policies at national and EU level. NTUA presented 'The role of Performance Indicators in the implementation of Road Safety Programmes'.
