Towards a Global Strategic Research Agenda for Road Safety

With more than one million road fatalities per year and no indication of a downward trend, worldwide accident statistics are alarming. Progress achieved in Europe is to a large extent based on intensive public research, the focus of which is currently moving away from road safety towards the greening of road transport, though. Therefore, the PROS project has been established to develop commonly agreed European priorities in road safety research. The objective of this special session is to present the priorities identified in PROS, discuss future opportunities of global research cooperation in this field and explore the potential of a global road safety research agenda.
